The essential ingredients for learning are having fun and being engaged. OzHarvest's new Food Education and Sustainability Training (FEAST) program is both!

This new curriculum-aligned education program is designed for primary school students in Years 5-6 and explores the role food plays in everyday lives, the importance of protecting the planet through sustainability, reducing food waste and nutrition education.

FEAST can be easily implemented in any classroom and is made up of the following elements:

- A **curriculum-ready package** which includes lesson plans and student activities to support schools with the Stage-3 Australian Curriculum and NSW Syllabus in (STEM) and the cross-curriculum priority of Sustainability.
- **Kitchen kits** to ensure cooking and food education is accessible to all children in a classroom setting.
- A **website** with **e-learning portal** for teachers, students and community members to access resources and share information.
- **Professional Development Training** for teachers contributes 6-hours towards maintaining Australian Professional Standards Authority (NESA) Proficient Teacher Accreditation.

FEAST delivers vital education to the entire school community through developing cooking skills, positive eating behaviours, enhancing nutritional literacy and reducing food waste. It involves teachers, families, care-givers and the whole school community to encourage healthy and thriving communities.

PHASE 1: PILOT (MAY-OCT 2018)

The program is currently being piloted with four primary schools in the Sydney area.

PHASE 2: NSW ROLL OUT (JAN-DEC 2019)

FEAST will be expanded and scaled across other primary schools in New South Wales.

PHASE 3: NATIONAL LAUNCH (JAN 2020)

FEAST will launch nationally and be available to all primary schools in Australia (subject to funding).
